### GRAPES:

100% Pinot Noir

### TERROIR:

Grapes sourced from oldest Pinot Noir vineyard in Kent, on an ancient Kent manor.

### VINES:

Hand harvested for whole bunches. Very low yields provide excellent concentration of flavour.

### VINIFICATION:

Whole bunch press, fermentation in stainless steel. Filtered and stabilised for freshness.

### MATURATION:

Settled in stainless steel and bottled within a year of harvest.

### TASTING NOTES:

A delicious rosé with heady scents of raspberry and thyme on a crisp, dry palate with a gentle, smooth touch of tannin; supple and sensual feel to caress and brighten your taste buds.

### PAIRING SUGGESTION:

The wine has more depth than most English roses and, whilst a great aperitif, can partner a host of dishes.

### SERVING TEMP:

8-12°C
