TERROIR:

Grown on the Brenley Farm, midway between the sea and Canterbury, with rolling fields of fruit orchards and hops.

VINES:

Vines planted in 2009. Hand harvested for whole bunches.

VINIFICATION:

Whole bunch press, cool fermentation at 18°C in stainless steel. Filtered and stabilised for freshness.

MATURATION:

Settled in stainless steel and bottled within a year of harvest.

TASTING NOTES:

A beautiful, aromatic dry wine offering the freshness of an English spring morning with flavours of lime, elderflower and green apple on a light, bright palate. Awaken your senses with this beautiful expression of Kent sunshine.

PARING SUGGESTION:

Perfect on its own or with fresh salads: try it with goats cheese.
