PRODUCER IN A NUTSHELL:

The BARREAU vineyard is a family estate passed down from generation to generation since 1782. Our two Châteaux, Haut-Garriga and Coutreau, are located in the wine-growing Entre-deux-Mers area, 10km away from St Emilion and 30 km from Bordeaux. Nowadays we manage 75 hectares of vines.



HOW THE WINE IS GROWN:

Sustainable in the vineyard with HEV level 3 certification. Terroir: Chalky clay.

VINIFICATION:

20 days of skin contact maceration in a stainless tank before digging out. Controlled temperature from 22 to 30°C with daily pumping-over. Malolactic fermentation and ageing in a stainless tank.

TASTING NOTES:

Deep ruby colour. Dry, high acidity, soft tannin feeling, white cherry, cranberries and forest fruits, medium body. Round finish.

FOOD PAIRING:

Grilled and roast lamb with garlic and rosemary. Roast beef, veal and venison. Steak pies.

SERVING TEMP:

16-18C

RECOMMENDED GLASS:

Red wine glass
